

## BLUEGRASS HARLEY-DAVIDSON Charity & Donation Guidelines

Bluegrass Harley-Davidson is pleased to provide charitable support to not-for-profit organizations throughout our community. While we wish we could approve every request for support that we receive, due to limited resources, we have created the following guidelines and criteria.

## TYPES OF ORGANIZATIONS MOST LIKELY TO RECEIVE SUPPORT:

- Organizations which meet local needs and serve people in Jefferson and surrounding counties
- Motorcycle charity rides that start, stop, or end at Bluegrass Harley-Davidson
- Motorcycle related charities and organizations
- Organizations which are led, organized, or actively supported by customers of Bluegrass Harley-Davidson

## TYPES OF SUPPORT ORGANIZATIONS CAN REQUEST:

- Host location for charity rides (start point, end point, or route stop)
- Merchandise/gift card donations. Items donated by Bluegrass Harley-Davidson can be raffled or auctioned by the
  organization to generate funds.
- Cash sponsorship towards charitable or fundraising activity
- Allowing organizations to conduct fundraising activities on-site at Bluegrass Harley-Davidson (must provide specific dates)
- Post event and ride flyers on our community bulletin board. (Additional promotional support available for events hosted by Bluegrass Harley-Davidson).

## **DONATION APPROVAL PROCESS:**

- Organizations must submit their request using the Bluegrass Harley-Davidson online donation request form at least 60 days in advance of needed donation. (Donation requests will not be reviewed if submitted via phone, email or in person request)
- Be as detailed as possible in your request including, who your organizations is, their mission/charitable cause, who/how they serve the local community, and the specific nature of your request (merchandise donation, event host, etc.)
- Bluegrass Harley-Davidson reviews requests twice each month.
- You will be notified if your request is approved and ready for pick-up. Due to the large volume of requests, we are
  not able to contact organizations whose requests are not approved.
